- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.
- After logging in, click on the Family Information button in the left menu.

If you believe your packet was submitted and did not receive this email, first please check your ParentsWeb account for the packet. THRIVENT FINANCIAL NEWS

Owners of individual retirement accounts who are at least age 70 1/2 can contribute some or all of their IRAs to charity. Why would they want to when they've been making contributions for years in anticipation of the day when they would retire? They do it because it can be advantageous from a tax perspective in some situations. A **qualified charitable distribution (QCD)** is a distribution from an IRA directly to an eligible charity, like Emanuel Lutheran Church or Central Lutheran School, bypassing the owner of the account so he's not taxed on it. QCDs count toward your **required minimum distribution** for the year. If you have to take RMDs but don't really want or need the money, QCDs are a good way to distribute the minimum required amount out of the IRA.
