If you have a child that is currently enrolled in our Kindergarten program, please be sure to submit all needed health records to the office as soon as possible. Additional copies are available in the office if needed.

The Kindergarten Health forms include:

- CHIRP Consent
- MCT vision screening
- Immunization record
- Health Questionnaire
- Physician Certificate of Examination
- Dental Exam
- Medication consent (if applicable)

If your child is new to the school this year, then a current immunization record is needed. If you have not yet submitted this to the school office please do so.
