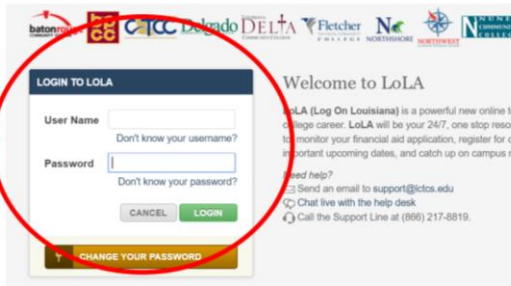
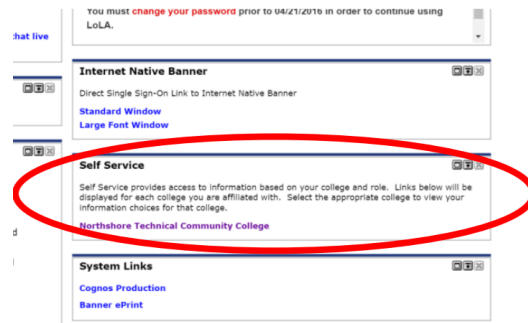


How to Review Assigned Advisor and Declared Program of Study
