At least 80% of Medical Assistant Students enrolled in MAST 1110 will score a minimum of 70% on their Maslow's Hierarchy of Basic Needs Quiz.

Summary of Findings:

81.5% of students successfully completed objective. (54 total students: 44 passed, 10 failed)

Target Achievement:

Met

Analysis of Results:

The target for this outcome was met. Students were placed in groups and provided scenarios and asked to list and place needs in order. Students tended to perform well in groups/working with peers but struggled individually. Faculty noted that some students struggled with understanding and comprehending the order of the hierarchy.

Summary of Findings:

82.6% of students successfully completed objective. (46 total students: 38 passed, 8 failed)

Target Achievement:

Met

Analysis of Results:

The target was met for this measure. Students enjoyed this assignment and the multiple methods of content delivery. Some students tended to struggle with writing the essay and lost points related to grammar (e.g. punctuation, spelling). Also, critical thinking was an issue for students. Implementing more critical thinking activities across the board can be an area of improvement.

Summary of Findings:

69.6% of students successfully completed objective. (56 total students: 39 passed, 17 failed)

Target Achievement:

Not Met

Analysis of Results:

The established target for this measure was not met. Faculty reported that students tended to learn better from visual aids (e.g. YouTube videos) as well as hands on application. There were some challenges with getting students to understand blood pressure concepts, utilizing listening skills, and being confident in performing tasks. The use of the new blood pressure simulation arms implemented toward the end of the cycle helped significantly and will be utilized more. Moving forward, instruction will aim to incorporate visual, hands on, and audio learning activities, as well as, provide multiple opportunities for students to practice.

Summary of Findings:

94.6% of students successfully completed objective. (37 total students: 35 passed, 2 failed)

Target Achievement:

Analysis of Results:

The target set for this measure was met. Students performed well on this measure due to a lot of hands-on training, instructor demonstration and practice. Students who struggled typically did not take advantage of one-on-one assistance provided by instructor.

for Measure 1 (SLO 3)

Summary of Findings:

97.0% of students successfully completed objective. (33 total students: 32 passed, 1 failed)).

Target Achievement:

Exceeded

Analysis of Results:

The established target for this measure was met and exceeded. However, faculty did report that some students did not perform well as it related to professionalism and understanding expectations from industry. Students tended to score low on attitude, initiative and attire. Moving forward, increased instruction time can be given to addressing professionalism concepts throughout the course as opposed to only once during the semester. Current activities such as role playing/scenario-based exercises; dress for success days/mock interviews, and utilizing classroom contracts related to professionalism can be enhanced.

83.7% of students successfully completed objective. (49 total students: 41 passed, 8 failed)

Target Achievement:

Analysis of Results:

The target set for this measure was met. Students struggled with writing resumes (e.g. grammar) and compiling letters of recommendation. Students lacked basic English skills. Students are required to enroll in a Business English course to improve skills (for dual-enrolled high school students, skills are taught at high school level). Instruction may benefit from coordinating and aligning course content taught and course assignments required in ENGL 1030 and HCOR 1160.

Summary of Findings:

75.0% of students successfully completed objective. (56 total students: 42 passed, 14 failed)

Target Achievement:

Not Met

Analysis of Results:

Unfortunately, the target set for this measure was not met. Faculty reported that some students struggled with understanding Medical Assistant fundamental concepts. In terms of charting, students lacked basic English skills and lost points for poor grammar. Instruction will incorporate more repetition of certain skills (e.g. checking for vital signs, blood pressure, temp pulse, respiration) as well as opportunities for

students to demonstrate their ability to critically think.

97.0% of students successfully completed objective. (33 total students: 32 passed, 1 failed)

Analysis of Results:

The target for this measure was met and exceeded. Students are well prepared for their externship evaluation as it is a culmination of their learning experience. The majority of students performed well here, however, industry has expressed concerns related to students' soft skills as well as reading physician orders and understanding them.

The established target was met and exceeded. NHA study guides were implemented and were a great asset. Study guides should be provided at the start of the program as opposed to prior to the exam. Study guides provided students with opportunities for self-directed learning and opportunities to practice certification exam questions.
