Mrs. Lang called the meeting to order at 9:30 am

It was voted to dismiss the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting.

Mrs. Lang updated the members that we now have 2 more clinical sites that are accessible to students for clinicals now: Mary Bird Perkins Cancer Center in Covington and Riverside Medical Center in Franklinton.

Mrs. Lang also stated that the Admission Criteria has changed to enter the program.

Arithmetic Test has changed from a required score of 260 to a 270; Reading and Writing have stayed the same.

Mrs. Marceaux stated that the changes were made in order to have a different level of preparation for students entering the program.

Mrs. Lang further explained the changes of a Ranking Criteria that is being done for each student entering the program. This gives points for Accuplacer scores; being a CNA: PCT; and if they have taken and passed the PNUR class.

Mrs. Marceaux explained the reason for the ranking criteria and drop rates, student admission requirement this makes for taking a better range of students who are prepared to succeed with the program.

Mrs. Garbo stated that this will make it more competitive and better results in the completion of the program.

Lisa Underwood explained the Program of Content in the Program:

Technical Diploma

Associate of Applied Science

Contents have changed: Using FA Davis and ATI

This together making consistent learning across all campus through course leads and faculty which makes for a better success rate.

LPN program is a 18 month course

Tori Pullen explained the Delivery Mode of Learning:

Two to three days of classroom learning

Two days of Clinicals

Pen and Paper Testing this being due to testing integrity

ATI testing for students with provides a deeper depth of testing and learning; holds each student accountable.

Mrs. Garbo ask about admission and if students were admitted twice a year; this being Spring and Fall.

Mrs. Marceaux explained about the regulations and being on provisional accreditation. We will not be enrolling a Spring 2022 class due to the pass rates and State Board requires an 80% pass rate and we have been in the 70 percentiles.

We will not have a Spring class and all of our other classes will remain under provisional probationary. Furthermore, explaining about failure rates during the COVID pandemic and Hurricanes.

Mrs. Marceaux did explain about the site visit and State Board is pleased with the progress and changes that are being put in place.

Mrs. Garbo ask about was this across all campuses and Mrs. Marceaux explained how LTCC is petitioning to the board to become all one program instead of different campus being under one umbrella. There is to be another board meeting in March

Mrs. Garbo added that this hurts OLOA because of the LPN's that have succeeded in the program applying at the hospital.

Mrs. Lang called the meeting to order at 2:00 PM

It was voted to dismiss the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting.

Mrs. Lang updated the members that we clinicals now. Building Blocks Academy for Pediatric Rotation and Bens Ford Christian School rotation for grades K- 4 thru 2nd Grade. Also, we have a contract with Boys Scouts of America Day Camp in Bush, La during the summer.

Admissions requirements are the same from before with the scores and GPA remaining the same. Arithmetic Test has changed from a required score of 260 to a 270; Reading and Writing have stayed the same. A GPA of 2.0 is still in place for admissions to the program.

The clinical hours are 800 hours and 700 hours of class time. ATI will have more weight with the student scores. Length of program 18 months.

Lisa Underwood explained the Delivery Mode: Restructure Mode to ATI for student success. This has been streamlined across all campuses; grading is the same. Stated that the Senior class having been through COVID had a 89% pass rate.

Rose Dedeaux told of the new equipment that has been purchased by the Nursing Department for the in house lab:

6 Dinemap Machines

- 1 Heart and Lung Machine
- 2 IV arms- a female and male

Michelle Burris: Spoke on Student Evaluation changes and that we have implemented the TRAC PRAC Program for students to log in and GPS which calculates log in times. This document provides learned skills for the days students are in clinical settings. This also lets the Instructors Evaluate students and the progress of what the student is learning in clinical. All information is exported and saved for Clinical Evaluations and will show weekly progress. This also tracs hours of clinical rotation on each student.

Mrs. Lang spoke of the Dual Enrollment HS start in the near future where a High School Student in their Junior year can take A&P with Nutrition and Medical Terminology; and their senior year take Both Fundamentals and Clinicals. Mrs. Marceux who is the Provost over Nursing met with Bens Ford Christian School; Washington Parish School System and Bogalusa City School System and all were excited about starting. St. Tammany Parish School system has a start date of Fall 2022.

We also had and onsite visit from North Oaks in Hammond about implementing a Tele Med Clinic once a month here on Sullivan Campus where the Public can come for evaluation / checkups.

Bridget Stokes inquired about enrollment with the students and is excited that enrollment has picked up and an new class will be starting in August 2022.

Kristen Page: ask Tren Garbo from OLOA about tracking the students and if there is a room where students can meet for paperwork from 4-6 each afternoon. Tren stated the boardroom would most likely be available.

In closing: Mrs. Lang stated there has been an overall improvement in students scores and the Ranking Program for incoming students is still in place.

More Information will be forthcoming on the RN bridge program starting on the Lacombe Campus.
