

How to ACCESS the Internet using a BYOD

The open Wireless Wi-Fi Network is called [NWHSC Access](#). This open network will require each end user to sign in to our web filter. If the following screen does not automatically appear, close your internet browser and reopen. When you do, attempt to go to [poker.com](#). This will bring up the screen shown below. Sign in using your Computer login / Harmony username and password.

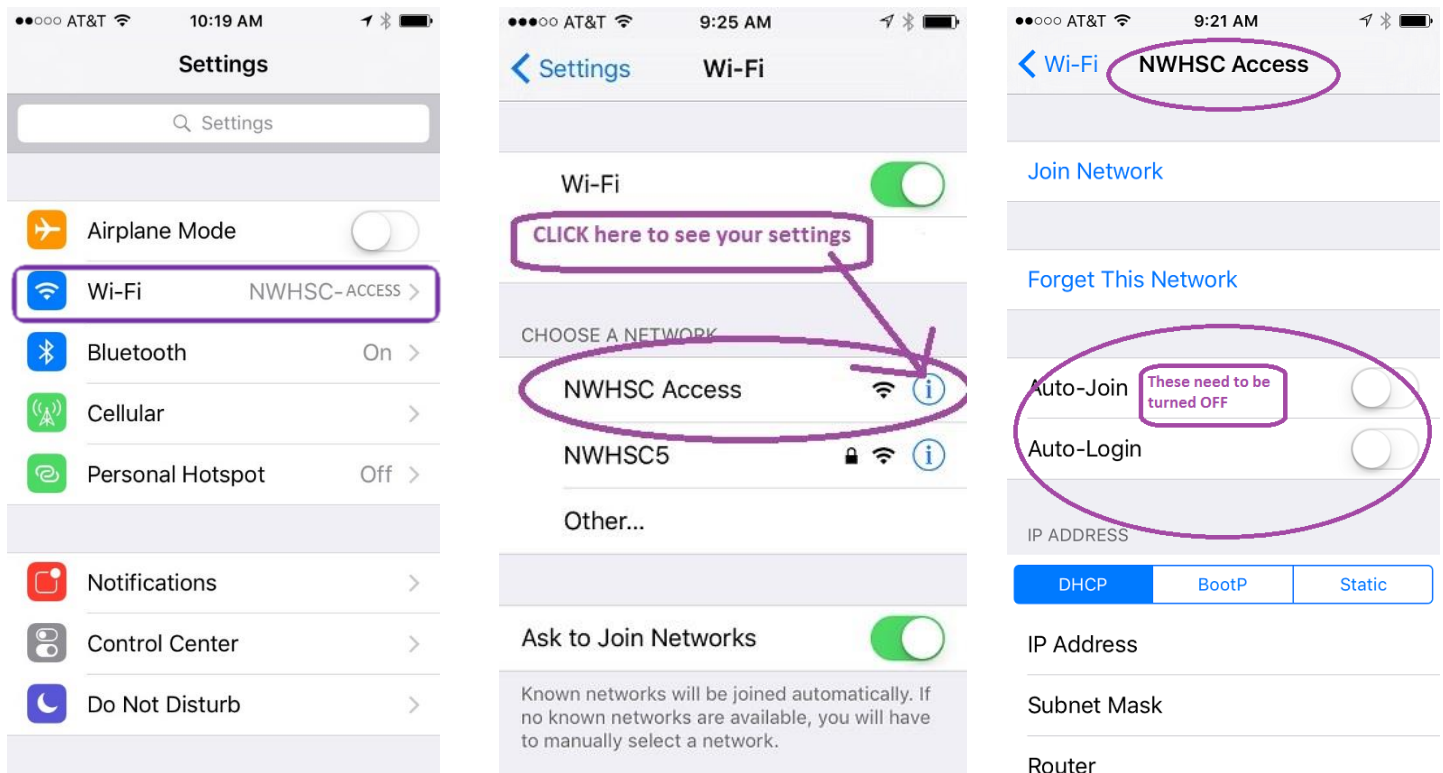


Once the end user logs in they will have the access previously assigned to them as a student or a staff member. Once an end user logs into our system they will remain signed in for 12 hours. There are some areas of the buildings where having to re-log in may become necessary. Depending on where in the building the end user moves to they "may" have to sign in again because of how the Access Points needed to be set up. If this should be the case, then the end user will know because they will be prompted to login when they attempt go to the Internet.

If a teacher needs to use Web Zones for a class project where students would not normally have access, students can now CLICK on the Instructor's Web Zone page link and input the information their teacher provides. Teacher instructions for creating Web Zones are located in the NWHSC Collaboration Corner Resource area in Schoology.
