



## Free childcare for children of Essential Workers – Tukwila Elementary School

**Mon to Friday 7am – 4pm : Starts Monday 30 March**

In partnership with Tukwila Public Schools, Boys & Girls Clubs of King County will offer extended day programming at Tukwila Elementary School starting **Monday, March 30**. Programming will be available for children of essential workers and first responders from 7am until 4pm daily. This is a free service.

We are following all guidelines set out by Public Health under which this service falls.

This service is ONLY available for those Essential Workers in the Tukwila Area who have no alternatives for childcare during the CV-19 health crisis. Occupation workers identified by Washington State as essential activities occupations during the Coronavirus outbreak include:

- First Responders and Public Safety Personnel (e.g., Police, Firefighters, Emergency Dispatchers, Department of Corrections)
- Public Health and Safety (e.g., Metro Bus Drivers, Sanitation Services, Utilities, Public Health Employees)
- Healthcare Workers
- Grocery Stores, Pharmacies, Convenience Stores, Gas Stations, Pet Stores, Laundromats, and Bank Workers, essential delivery workers (e.g., USPS, UPS, FedEx, Amazon, etc.)
- Day Care and Child Care Workers

Our focus is to support families experiencing challenges due to school closures by ensuring youth have a fun, educational place to go during the day.

Workers will be asked to provide a work I-D or similar evidence that shows they fall within the essential worker categories. Children will go through a brief health check on drop off each day, failure to pass this will mean a child can not attend.
