We are excited to offer the School-Day Preliminary Scholastic Assessment Test (or PSAT) at Lake View High School on Wednesday, October 11, 2017. All **9th, 10th, and 11th grade students** will have the opportunity to test for free during school hours at our high school.

Students are expected to arrive by 7:30am to allow time to for student entry procedures so that they are able to report to their testing room. After testing, students will be provided lunch and engage in two afternoon learning activities and then will have an early release at 2:35pm.

The PSAT is a curriculum-based, high-stakes test that will provide an important measure of academic achievement as students prepare for post-secondary college and career opportunities. Participation in the PSAT also gives students valuable skills feedback, connects them with scholarship opportunities, and helps them select the best fit for college.

The PSAT also yields important student information for our teachers in designing appropriate classroom tasks, as well as provides our families with an indicator of our effectiveness as a school.

Students in need of extra supports, who have been approved for accommodations by College Board, will be taking the exam with their approved accommodations as dictated by their 504 plan or IEP.

12th Grade Students - October 11th will be a full attendance day for our 12th graders as well. Our corporate and community partners have arranged a set of opportunities for our 12th grade students. Included in these opportunities are visits to local college campuses and service learning activities.
