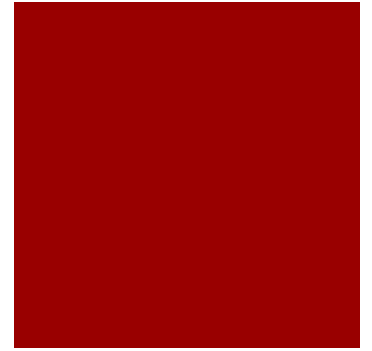

- Provided midyear evaluations to every ESP/PSRP in the building

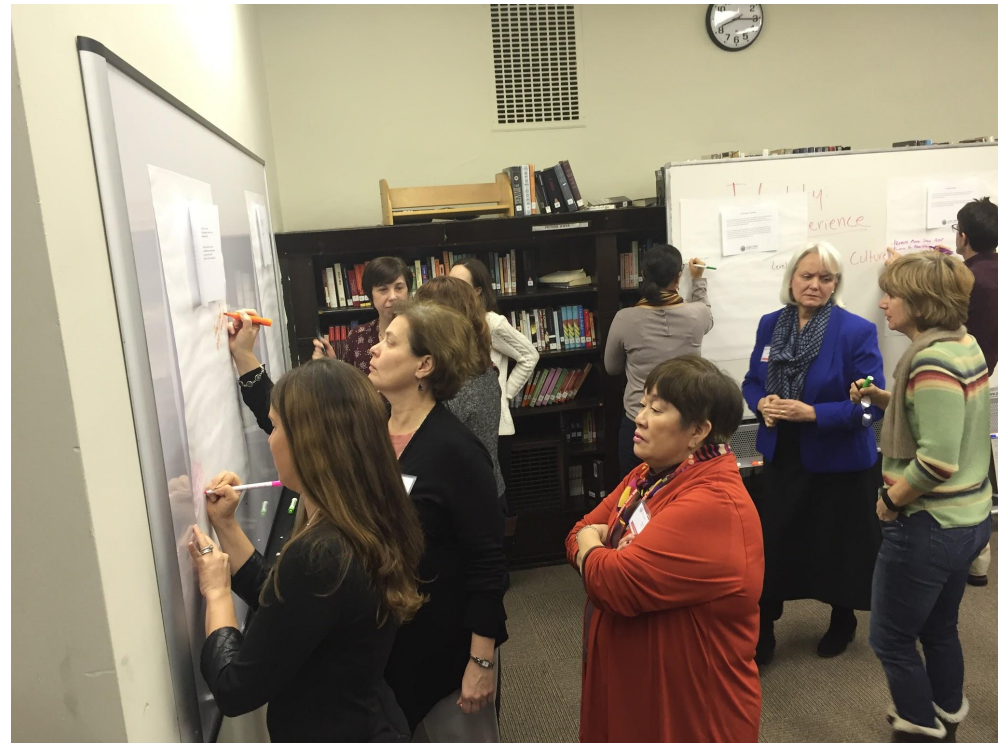
COMPETENCY C: BUILDS A CULTURE FOCUSED ON COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS
