1. LSC Chair Peggy Herrington called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Roll call was taken and a quorum established.
2. Approval of Agenda: Arnold Davis moved to approve the agenda for the LSC meeting. Amy O’Rourke seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.
3. Approval of Minutes from the 05-17-18 meeting: Peggy Herrington moved to approve the minutes (subject to student fee increase being added) and Phil English seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.
4. Public Participation: Sarah Makela from GROWCommunity gave monthly updates. She distributed GROWCommunity flyers encouraging everyone to take their online survey before 09-17-18.
5. New Business:
 - a. Approval of Internal Accounts: LSC members received copies of the Internal Accounting Cash Disbursements Journal, Cash Receipts Journal and Balance Sheet. Phil English moved to approve the internal accounts and Jose Valencia seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.
 - b. Approval of Budget Transfers & Adjustments: LSC members received the Budget Transfer Report and the Book Transfer Report. Mary Lubben moved to approve the nine budget transfers totally \$15,000 and Phil English seconded the motion. Approved unanimously. Peggy Herrington moved to approve the four book transfers totally \$7,150 and Daniel Bender seconded the motion. Approved

unanimously.

- e. Approval of Fundraisers: boys soccer team will be selling raffle tickets to purchase new uniforms. Tickets are \$2 each and the prize is a GoPro camera. Peggy Herrington moved to approve the fundraiser and Anna Proni seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.

6. Reports:

a. Chair:

Peggy Herrington announced that Ana Breen had resigned as an LSC parent rep due to work commitments. She will have to submit resignation in writing and her position will need to be filled.

Peggy Herrington introduced Dan Meyer from the Science in Society Department at Northwestern University. He will have an office at Lake View (Rm. 235) and will also be working with Mather HS. He will be providing in-service teacher education.

b. Principal: LSC members received copy of Principal's Report featuring Constructions Updates, Culture & Climate, Curriculum & Assessment, STEM Teaching & Learning and Family, Community & Partners.

Construction Updates: the turf field, playground and parking lot are all complete. Interior floors largely complete. The gym will be ready on 9/4. A/C installation to begin shortly (on the east side first). By spring 2019, all classrooms should have A/C (no A/C in gym or cafeteria).

Culture & Climate: student led Freshman Orientation took place this week. The six student bathrooms were deep cleaned over the summer and will undergo two cleanings per day when the new school year begins. The ventilations systems are now working and QR code reporting system will continue this year. Looking into painting and new mirrors (possible lead abatement needed) and getting new partitions.

Curriculum & Assessment: new textbooks for AP classes were purchased. A master schedule to support learning among all students was created. LVHS won their appeal for SPED positions. School still needs to hire three SPED positions and one math position.

STEM Teaching & Learning: New AP Dania Saleh attended the Reading Apprentice training, as did fifteen current and new teachers. Worked with RA experts in creating coaching structures to support teams in developing RA schoolwide.

Family, Community, University & Corporate Partnerships: Lake View's partnership with Northwestern University and Dan Meyer was reviewed. AP Resh is exploring a partnership with Bit Space on Lawrence Avenue as a way to expand the school's Makerspace. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony on 8/25 to celebrate the new turf field and building renovations. Several LVHS students will be helping out at the annual Graceland West block party on 8/26. Volunteers needed to man a beer

tent at Taco Fest on 9/15. All tips received will go to Lake View High School.

d. PPLC: no report.

e. Community Relations: Sarah Makela from GROWCommunity spoke earlier in the meeting.
