1. LSC Chair Peggy Herrington called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Roll call was taken and a quorum established.

3. Approval of Minutes from the 10-20-17 meeting: Mary Lubben moved to approve the minutes and Peggy Herrington seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.
4. Public Participation: Sarah Makela presented monthly GROWCommunity update: GROWCommunity Alderman Summit recently took place at Amundsen High School. The goal was to share accomplishments and highlights of the Aldermen and GROWCommunity. The five aldermen that are part of GROWCommunity are: Pawar, O’Connor, Waguespack, Cappleman and Tunney. All were present at the summit with the exception of Tunney. Alderman Arena of the 45<sup>th</sup> Ward was also present to learn more about the neighborhood K-12 system and possibly replicate it in his ward.

**a.** Chair: Peggy Herrington reminded everyone that LSC members are elected to two year terms. The next LSC elections and polls will be held Thursday, April 19, 2018 for high schools.

**b.** Principal: LSC members received copy of Principal's Report outlining Competencies A-E and slide show presentation featuring Winning Wildcats and GROWCommunity and GoCPS Applications

COMPETENCY A: Champions teacher and staff excellence through continuous improvement to develop and achieve the vision of high expectations for all students. Engaged teachers in using SAT/PSAT skill insight document to understand rigor. Engaged RA cohort leadership in understanding data from two learning walks to identify areas of strength and continued growth in RA practice.

COMPETENCY B: Creates powerful professional learning systems that guarantee learning for students. Developing a professional learning community with Mather High School and the CPS Office of STEM. Engaged FOT team in using data to identify at-risk students and obtaining teacher sponsors for them.

COMPETENCY C: Builds a culture focused on college and career readiness. Holding talking circles in classes to better understand why students may feel unsafe in different areas of the building. Engaged partners in creating the Lake View Lunch and Learn series which focuses on a new career cluster each month, with speakers and food for students provided by partner sponsors.

COMPETENCY D: empowers and motivates families and the community to become engaged. Entered new partnership with Nielsen and Milliman. The Black Student Union participated in MLK "Day of Service" at Gale Elementary School. Engaged with CPS departments to ensure a smooth and stress-free start to CPS Score! Basketball at LVHS. Invited families to the 1/26/18 "Golden Ticket" ceremony for students invited to AP/DDC courses.

COMPETENCY E: Relentlessly pursues self-disciplined thinking and action. Used EOS data to identify students from underrepresented groups who can be successful in AP/DC classes, and designed outreach efforts to support those students.

Winning Wildcats: Nine LVHS students all took first place awards at the regional science fair this month. The Boys Basketball team went 4-1 at the Holy Trinity Tournament and Jasemin Wilson went All-Tournament at the Guerin Prep Yule Tide. Victoria Goite presented at the all-city Art Exhibition at the SAIC.
