Construction Updates

- Contract to refloor main office suite, counseling office, and deans' office approved and starting in two weeks!
- Mirrors to be installed next week.

Professional Learning Teams

Vision: *High-functioning professional learning teams drive school improvement through critical thinking cycles.*

- Equity team held its first purpose-setting dialogue with administration
- Security team started home visits to students who have not been attending school and calls and emails have not gotten responses from.
- The Lab team has begun its Tier 2 support intervention for 9th grade students who are in need of added support.
- The 9th grade team has worked to align the schoolwide MTSS goal with the executive functioning initiative.

Next Steps:

- Create progress monitoring tools that ensure fidelity of implementation for the executive functioning lessons/skills being taught to 9th graders.

Culture & Climate

Vision: *Lake View HS is a safe, supportive, and inclusive community of learners committed to academic and personal growth through ownership, restoration, and reflection.*

- Climate team met to determine uniform policies for and best practices to prevent tardies, cameras, Zoom Bombers.
- The Culture team created and shared the first virtual assembly of the year to celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month.
- Student Voice has been established and student representatives will be joining the Equity, Culture, Climate, and WILs meetings going forward.

Next Steps:

- The Culture team worked to create the plan for the Virtual Open-House set on Nov. 7th.

Curriculum & Assessment

Vision: *Curriculum and Assessment at Lake View promote deep STEM learning through mastery of standards-based, rigorous, authentic tasks.*

- Grade-Level Success Teams met to learn about Equity in Grading and set course team intentions for the year.



- Hosted just over 100 12th graders for the SAT with Essay on the 14th. This test is a CPS requirement for graduation.
- Planned work for SY21 to expand equity in curricular offerings for SY22 (AP courses, culturally responsive course offerings, etc.).
- Connecting with Truman College to create more dual enrollment opportunities for the 2021-2022 school year.

Next Steps:

- Create and revise semester plan for Grade-Level Success Teams.
- Roll out EOS Questionnaires for students and staff to support AP recruitment and support.

STEM Teaching and Learning

Vision: STEM Teaching and Learning at LVHS develop student ownership of 21st Century Skills and Habits of Mind, including critical thinking and disciplinary literacy, to prepare students for college and careers.

- Choir Teacher and Music Department Lead Ms. Ramaswamy stepped up to be a lead in remote learning (RL) for teachers, and will be meeting with departments and individual teachers to support their RL needs.
- Google Meets “breakout rooms” extension rolled out and employed by teachers in all departments.
- Recommendations work by the Senior Success Team resulted in learning for all team members (other teachers to be addressed soon!) about how to write more effective college and scholarship recommendations for students.
- Schoolwide MTSS structures rolled out in grades 10-12.
- Admins conducted 245 short classroom observations and gave feedback to teachers.

Next Steps:

- Continue support for MTSS in grade-level success team meetings.
- Continue longer observations for teacher feedback and admin learning.

Family, Community, University, and Corporate Partnerships

Vision: Partnerships at Lake View High School are designed to support our students’ development of 21st Century Skills and enhance postsecondary options through direct interactions with students and teachers.

- Erie Health Center and Alternatives Inc. therapists met with Care Team and both are receiving referrals for individual counseling on general mental health and for Alternatives, substance abuse.
- Protocol for in-person work completed, so students who need a day in the building or a few weeks in the building to get questions answered and set new, positive learning habits can do so.
- PAC meeting is set for October 28th, 2020.
- Created structures for online Virtual Open House on November 7.
