### Curriculum & Assessment

**Vision:** *Curriculum and Assessment at Lake View promote deep STEM learning through mastery of standards-based, rigorous, authentic tasks.*

- WIL team reviewed rubrics from all departments and generated data to support further planning.
- Admin team engaged in conversations with departments about implementing C4 College/Career curriculum in 11th and 12th grade.

### Next Steps:

- Identify departments to support grade-level postsecondary learning for grades 10-12 (grade 9 will be part of Frosh Seminar)
- Research one-to-one technology best practices and create professional learning for SY21-22.

### STEM Teaching and Learning



**Vision:** *STEM Teaching and Learning at LVHS develop student ownership of 21st Century Skills and Habits of Mind, including critical thinking and disciplinary literacy, to prepare students for college and careers.*

- Summer Melt team meeting four hours daily to ensure that LV graduates (2021 and 2020) have successful transitions to their next steps.

**Family, Community, University, and Corporate Partnerships**

**Vision:** *Partnerships at Lake View High School are designed to support our students' development of 21st Century Skills and enhance postsecondary options through direct interactions with students and teachers.*

- Eleven students signed up for first course with National Education Equity Lab, *Poetry in America: The Streets from Whitman to Hip-Hop*; working to identify courses those students would like to drop. (A, C, D)
- Rented facilities to YMCA for summer programming. (D)
- Launched summer re-engagement efforts with calls, home visits, and first day of programming. Goal is to connect with at least 90% of students who have disengaged from school to ensure they have the supports and connections they need to return to LV in the fall. (C, D, E)
- Identified and in hiring process for Director of External Relations and Athletics. (C, D)
- FOLV donated gifts (Bluetooth Speakers) for all graduating seniors (D)
