3. Student may use any form of media (crayons, colored pencils, paint, etc.).
4. 3-D submissions will not be accepted.
5. Submission may be framed and/or mounted but not required. No glass is allowed in frames.
6. Place name, grade and homeroom teacher on the **back** of the submission. Do not place any identifying items on the front. Please cover any names on the front of your artwork.
7. Fill out both sides of your registration form. Both sides must be included with your submission.
8. Cover your information on the back side of your work with the side of the registration form stating, "attach this side facing up."
9. Due to the large amount of submissions, failure to follow any of the guidelines will cause elimination.

4. Submissions should be no longer than 5 pages.
5. Place name, grade and homeroom teacher on the **back** of the submission. Do not place any identifying items on the front. Please cover any names on the front of your creative writing piece.
6. Fill out both sides of your registration form. Both sides must be included with your submission.
7. Cover your information on the back side of your work with the side of the registration form stating, "attach this side facing up."
8. Due to the large amount of submissions, failure to follow any of the guidelines will cause elimination.

5. Submission may be framed and/or mounted but not required. No glass is allowed in frames.
6. Fill out both sides of your registration form. Both sides must be included with your submission.
7. Cover your information on the back side of your work with the side of the registration form stating, "attach this side facing up."
8. Due to the large amount of submissions, failure to follow any of the guidelines will cause elimination.
