Dear Parents,

Today, the Shrewsbury School Administration received information of a non-credible threat regarding a possible device in their school building. They immediately contacted local and county law enforcement and followed the protocols they have established. The school district immediately sent a letter to their community informing them of the situation.

Over the past three days, both RBR and Shrewsbury have dealt with safety and security issues that have necessitated law enforcement investigations. While Little Silver has comprehensive safety and security measures, as well as an extremely close working relationship with the Little Silver Police, we also depend on you.

We work hard to promote the philosophy of “**if you see something, say something.**” While students are encouraged to make good personal decisions, by virtue of their age, they need adult guidance in doing so. Children of all ages can learn that there are consequences to making poor decisions (posting threatening information online, making an inappropriate joke about a safety concern, making threatening comments out of anger etc.).

I ask that you to speak with your children, in an age appropriate manner, about safety and security issues. Please discuss the importance of being a responsible student/citizen, as well as the significance of reporting information that could pose a threat to others.

Let's work together to ensure the safety and security of our school community.
