The Higher Education Act of 1965(HEA), as amended by the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 (HEOA), includes many disclosure and reporting requirements. A disclosure is information that a post-secondary education institution is required to distribute or make available to another party, such as students or employees. A reporting requirement is information submitted to the U.S. Department of Education or other agencies. For certain topics, institutions are required to make information available to students or others and to submit to the Department of Education. In addition to federal requirements, Louisiana Legislature passed two compliance resolutions in the 2010 session: HCR 152 and HCR 197.
