Campus Access

Access to campus will be limited to members of the campus community and partners. When entering campus please report to one of the three entry points to have your temperature checked and receive clearance to access campus buildings.
Checkpoints: AST Front Entrance, Building D Entrance, Admin Bldg. Entrance.

Instruction

Course offerings have been updated to include significantly more opportunities for online learning and hybrid learning opportunities. Courses with hands on requirements like career and technical courses, health science and science labs and clinical experiences, internships and externship courses will include face to face learning.

To assure continuous access to instruction, students should secure regular access to a device that allows access to the internet, and can support technology like video conferencing, preparing documents and access to external sites like MyMathLab. WiFi and computer access will be available on campus. Students should watch for details for this access. The bookstore will also have devices available for purchase that meet course requirements.

Academic Support

Individual and group tutoring, study sessions, and success skills workshops will be available virtually through the Student Success Center. On-campus appointments can be requested if needed. The Library will be open with computers available for student use. Additional computer labs will be identified for students use as needed. Updates to the WIFI system will allow students stronger internet access on campus. Academic advisors will continue to be available virtually with on campus appointments available if needed.

Facial Coverings

Anyone accessing campus is required to wear a mask or face covering in all shared indoor spaces. We suggest bringing your own face coverings, but they are also available in the bookstore.

Healthy Reminders
