All students enrolled in a degree, diploma, or certificate program at Nunez Community College who meet the requirements established in the Nunez “Awarding Credit for Prior Learning” policy shall be eligible for and receive college credit (grade of P) via College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams, which measure mastery of college-level, introductory course content.

Students who achieve satisfactory scores on these exams can earn credit for the following courses:
