5 FOR SIX SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS

WHO CAN RECEIVE THE 5 FOR SIX SCHOLARSHIP?

Current Adult Education students who have NOT obtained their HiSET may be eligible.

WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP COVER?

Scholarship will cover tuition for 6 credit hours (includes career pathway and other courses).

Scholarship is awarded to students on a first come, first serve basis.

HOW IS THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED?

Step 1: Adult Education staff identifies and refers current HiSET program participants to Office of Admissions to complete application process. Students must have scored a minimum of 9th grade level in all subjects in either TABE A or D in order to be eligible.

Step 2: Adult education student meets with Admissions representative to determine final course enrollment eligibility requirements. Student will then apply for admissions and complete FAFSA application process.

Step 3: Eligible Adult Education student meets with Advisor to schedule classes.

Step 4: Student should visit the bookstore for textbooks and supplies.

Step 5: Student must commit to attending college and HiSET classes concurrently and regularly. Adult Education staff will notify Office of Financial Aid if the concurrent enrollment requirement is not being met.
