Q. How long will it take me to complete this program?

A. This program is designed to take **16 months** to complete.

Q. How much will this program cost me?

A. This program will cost **\$130,414** if completed within normal time.

Tuition & Fees: \$127,814

Q. What financing options are available to help me pay for this program?

Q. What licensure requirements does this program meet?

A. This program qualifies students to sit for Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) licensure as a Private Pilot, Commercial Pilot with an Instrument Rating and Certificated Flight Instructor with Instrument Rating for rotating wing aircraft.
