1. DETERMINE HOW TO PAY FOR CLASSES

SLCC offers many types of financial aid including TOPS, grants, loans, and scholarships. To apply for financial aid, complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov.

Use the **SLCC college code: 039563**. For more information visit www.solacc.edu/Financial-Aid.

2. COMPLETE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Complete an admissions application at www.solacc.edu/ApplyNow
- Provide immunization waiver or records.
- Males between 18 and 25 must submit a copy of Selective Service registration.

3. SUBMIT PLACEMENT INFORMATION

Students pursuing an associate-level degree must provide ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer scores taken within the last five years OR send transcripts from another college to SLCC showing that they have passed College Algebra and/or English Composition with a C or better. If test scores are needed, SLCC offers the Accuplacer at all campus locations. Visit solacc.edu/students/testing for more information. Always study before testing.

4. REGISTER CLASSES AT STUDENT SUCCESS LIVE

Classes are scheduled at a group registration session. You will receive an email invitation when it is time to schedule.

5. SECURE YOUR CLASSES

To prevent classes from being dropped, students must enroll in a payment plan, pay in full, or have financial aid for their full balance.

WHAT IS LOLA?

Log on Louisiana (LoLA) is your student information portal. LoLA makes it easy to manage your college journey with one-stop, 24/7 access to your student information. You will be notified by email of your login credentials. LoLA is used to update your contact information, register for classes, schedule classes, follow your application for financial aid, check your grades, and order transcripts.

HOW DO I LOG IN TO MY LOLA ACCOUNT?

Select the LoLA icon on **www.solacc.edu**. If this is the first time you're logging in, click "I don't know my password." You will be prompted to enter your social security number and date of birth to locate your username and password. We recommend using the verify personal information option.

TRACK YOUR FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION

1. Login to LoLA by clicking the LoLA icon on the SLCC website at **www.solacc.edu**.
2. Find the Self-Service box and select Student under South Louisiana Community College.
3. Under Financial Aid Links, click South Louisiana Community College (SLCC).
4. Select the Home tab.
