Snapshot of Keystone Elementary

 - Awarded Bronze Recognition from the State of Ohio
 - Highest Award You Can Recieve in 1st Year of PBIS Implementation

- **White-Student Registration**
 - Please Complete the Front and Back
- **Blue Residency Form**
 - Two Proofs of Residency
 - Electric, Gas, Water, Sewer, Cable/Internet, Monthly mortgage statement, Lease/rental agreement (the entire document including the signatures of both parties) DRIVER LICENSE IS NOT PROOF OF RESIDENCY
- **Yellow Student Information Sheet**
 - Please Complete the Front and Back
- **Birth Certificate**
 - Can be brought in at a later date if you do not have one available
- **Immunization Record**
 - Can be brought in at a later date if you do not have one available



Timeline

- **Kindergarten Registration**
 - February 11th & 13th, 2019 from 4:30-7:00 pm
 - February 19th through June 7th during normal office hours 8:00 am-4:00 pm
- **Kindergarten Screening and KRA Appointments**
 - August 26th-29th, 2019, during the school day
- **Kindergarten Orientation**
 - August 30th, 2019 at 10:00 am
- **Kindergarten 1st Day of School**
 - September 3rd, 2019



Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA)

- Given by teacher
- Will begin the week of August 26th and will be completed no later than November 1st
- Tests your child in areas of: **language and literacy, math, social skills, and physical well-being & motor development**
- Some questions are asked individually and some are through teacher observation
- Part of the Third Grade Guarantee
- Parents will receive a report
- Resource packet can be helpful



Measure of Academic Progress (MAP)

- Measures Reading and Math ability in grades K-12
- Will allow the teacher to see what the students are ready to learn
- Will be given to KDG. students in September or October
- Given in the fall, winter, and spring
- Computerized test read to students
- Parents will receive a progress report
