Powerschool Reminder

Here is a quick recap on how to set-up your parent account for Powerschool. First, you will need an Access ID and an Access Password. Our secretaries would be happy to help you get this information on your child, so please feel free to call KHS office at 440-355-2400.

Once on this page, please click on the Powerschool icon in the center of the purple menu bar.

Then, you will need to select the option to create an account. At this time, you will simply fill out the information on your child, including the Access ID and Access Password. You will then be able to sign-in to Powerschool.

Once you have created an account, please also remember to download the Powerschool APP on your smartphone, and you can access information and receive notifications.
