Connections Day School is a highly therapeutic environment for students in grades 4-12 who have been placed by local school districts, which have determined that the students' needs could not be met by their home school district programs. These students must have been determined to be eligible for special education as a result of a diagnosis of one or more of the following categories: Emotional Disability, Specific Learning Disability, Speech Language Impairment, Intellectual Disability, Other Health Impairment, Autism, or Traumatic Brain Injury.
