Position Summary:

The **.Net developer** will build software using languages and technologies of the .NET framework. They will create applications from scratch, refactor existing applications and provide user support. The developer will be able to write functional code with a sharp eye for spotting defects, be a team player and excellent communicator. This positions goal is to work with internal teams to design, develop and maintain software.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Participate in requirements analysis
- Collaborate with internal teams to produce software design and architecture
- Write clean, scalable code using .NET programming languages
- Test and deploy applications and systems
- Revise, update, refactor and debug code
- Improve existing software
- Develop documentation throughout the software development life cycle (SDLC)
- Serve as an expert on applications and provide technical support

Qualification Requirements:

- Proven experience as a .NET Developer or Application Developer
- Familiarity with the ASP.NET framework and design/architectural patterns (e.g. Model-View-Controller (MVC))
- Strong understanding of object-oriented programming
- Skill for writing reusable libraries
- Knowledge of the .NET languages (C# and/or VB.NET) and HTML5/CSS3/JavaScript
- Familiarity with web services/APIs (REST, SOAP, RPC)

- Understanding of Agile methodologies
- Familiarity with Microsoft SQL and IIS Servers
- Excellent troubleshooting and communication skills
- Experience using source control systems (GIT, SVN)
- Keen attention to detail
- BS/BA in Computer Science, Engineering or 3 years of software development work experience.
