



## LOWER ELEMENTARY SUPPLY & BOOK LIST 2020-2021 Grades 2-3

- 1     **2” black binder** for Cultural ( with **4 dividers** labeled: Botany, Zoology, History and Geography)
- 1     **2” red binder** for Math (with **4 dividers** labeled: Math 1, Math 2, Geometry and Miscellaneous)
- 1     **2” blue binder** for Language (with **5 dividers** labeled: Grammar, Mechanics, Word Study, SRA and Miscellaneous)

**Bring only the requested sizes for binders to insure that they fit on the classroom shelves.**

- 4     glue sticks
- 1     pair of scissors
- 1     plain pencil eraser (pink pearl)
- 1     set of soft lead colored pencils **sharpened (24 pencil set)**
- 2     **sturdy folders** (plastic coated) with pockets labeled homework and Spanish
- 1     **zipper pencil pouch – no bigger than 9”x7”**
- 1     **cloth placemat and napkin**
- 6     #2 pencils **sharpened (no pencil top decorations or mechanical pencils please)**
- 1     6” ruler (must fit in pencil pouch)
- 1     plain clipboard (not plastic)
