- **Deposit:** a \$100 deposit **per week** must accompany your application to reserve your child's spot. If there is an available spot, the \$100 deposit will be applied towards the week's tuition. If there is no space available, the full deposit will be returned to you.
- **Payment Due:** Payment (minus the deposit) is due the first day of each week.
- **Withdrawal & Refund Policy:** Until and including 05/14/21, if your plans change, we will refund 50% of your deposit payment. After 05/14/21, your payment is nonrefundable. Deposits for summer school DO NOT apply to fall tuition.
- **Payment:** Please make checks payable to Peninsula Montessori School.

**We require a minimum of two consecutive weeks for all Toddler and Pre-primary students.**



# 2021 SUMMER PROGRAMS SAFETY PROCEDURES

The following safety procedures are implemented in all classrooms and on playgrounds:

- Temperatures of all children and staff are taken daily with a no-contact infrared thermometer as they enter campus. (Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher will not be allowed to enter the facility.)
- Parents drop off and pick up their children curbside. (Toddler and pre-primary students use the front door entrance; transition and elementary students use the playground entrance.)
- Anti-bacterial disinfectants are used throughout the day to clean all surfaces, both indoors and out.
- There are no community snacks or meals served at school, however, children may bring their own food and beverages. There will be no food sharing between children.
- Floor decals are used to insure proper spacing of the children during circle time.
- With the exception of toddlers, masks are required to be worn by all adults and children during school hours.
- Frequent handwashing throughout the day is conducted, as well as the use of hand sanitizer as needed.
- Protective clear plexiglass barriers measuring 20" by 18" are on tables and desks to allow for safe social interaction.
- The school air filtration system ensures continual circulation and air purification.
- Social distancing is reinforced throughout the day through role play and frequent reminders.
- All classroom manipulatives used throughout the day are sanitized after each use.
- Outdoor play schedules are staggered to reduce the number of children in the same area at one time.
- All personal items must be labeled and are kept separate from others. Personal toys should be kept at home.
