Culture and Climate:

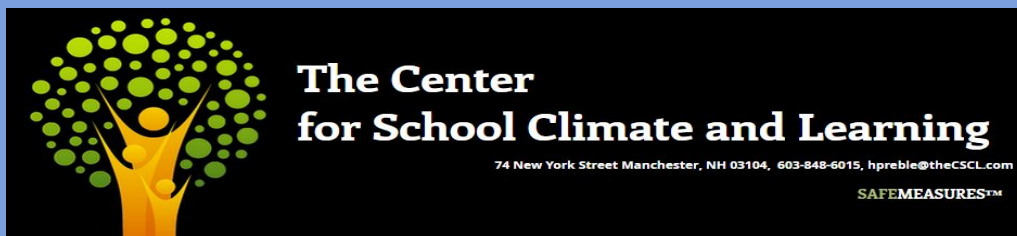
