

Welcome new EMHS students!

Please follow the instructions below:

1. Exit your student from their current school district
2. Complete the [Request for Student Records](#) form and return it to the Guidance Department
3. Complete the [PowerSchool Enrollment Express](#) pre-registration
4. The school Registrar will reach out to you to schedule an appointment for late August

The following information will be required at the time of your new student appointment *or before*:

- Proof of residency (*ex: electricity bill, deed, lease, cable bill*)
- Copy of student birth certificate
- Copy of custody orders/agreement (*if applicable*)
- Copy of immunization and most recent physical
- Parent/Guardian ID
- Updated transcript (*high school only*), most recent report card

- **SENIOR PORTRAITS:** Must be a minimum of 300dpi (at full scale) and must be emailed to tbell@eppingsd.org - if email is not an option please provide a labeled disk/thumb drive or submit a 5x7 photo to be scanned.
- **ALL SCHOOL CLOTHING RULES APPLY:** *NO HATS OR PROPS*, examples of props include: hats, cars/trucks, anything held in the hand, pets. Photos may be outdoors or indoors. Pictures or written material not following school policy or not within the guidelines of the yearbook will be returned to the student until corrections are made before being published.
