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This document represents a summary of important information you will need for senior events, trips and expectations, while you complete the end of your high school journey! Please be sure to read this document in its entirety, as it contains important dates and details.

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## END OF YEAR (graduating students) and GRADUATION INFORMATION:

- Each **FAMILY** will be given (eight) 8 reserved seats (tickets)
  - ◆ If graduation is **outside**, there will be eight (8) reserved seats per family, with overflow seating available.
  - ◆ If graduation is **inside**, there will be eight (8) seats for the O'Day Gymnasium. OPEN SEATING.
- School rules and regulations are in effect for all seniors at all school activities, including but not limited to: senior trips, senior night, rehearsals and graduation. Any violation may result in exclusion from the senior activities and could lead to further disciplinary action.
  - ◆ *Please do not jeopardize your graduation by violating school rules.*
- In order to participate in the activities, you are required to be on time for each event.
  - ◆ Graduation rehearsals are **MANDATORY**.
- In order to participate in the graduation ceremony, seniors must be within one (1) credit of meeting the graduation requirements. Students who have one (1) or fewer credits to complete **must** have an approved [Alternative Learning Plan](#) (pg 17) in place to be allowed to participate in the ceremony. See Guidance for more information.

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## END OF SEMESTER DATES, GRADES AND TRANSCRIPTS (*seniors only*):


- **Wednesday, June 1:** Last day for senior summatives, all school related items returned (except chromebooks)
    - Grades entered into PowerSchool by end of business day
  - **Thursday, June 2 - Wednesday, June 8:** Reassessment (*if necessary*)
    - *Required graduation credits not earned (greater than one (1) credit) by 2:25 on Wednesday 6/8, will result in removal from the graduation ceremony.*
  - **Week of June 13:** Final transcripts will be mailed to colleges based on the information provided in the digital Exit Interview you will complete at rehearsal. **NO FINAL TRANSCRIPTS WILL BE ISSUED PRIOR TO THIS DATE.**
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## OBLIGATIONS:

- These are items owed to the school district, including but not limited to; text books, media center materials, uniforms, cafeteria balances, etc. Chromebooks, bags and chargers will be collected at graduation rehearsal on Wednesday June 8th.
- Missing items not returned will result in a financial obligation that must be satisfied **NO LATER THAN END OF BUSINESS ON WEDNESDAY JUNE 8**. Obligations may be paid in cash or by check (*made payable to ESD*) with Mrs Bell in Guidance.
- Outstanding obligations after the deadline will result in diplomas being held until the obligation is met

## PROJECT GRADUATION INFORMATION

**PROJECT GRADUATION** – Will take place immediately following the graduation ceremony (approximate time between 7:45 and 8:00 p.m.). If a graduate wishes to participate in Project Graduation, they may **not** leave campus after the ceremony and **must** check-in with Project Grad immediately after changing into more casual clothes. Check-in will be located at the middle high school front entrance. Graduates participating in Project Graduation may drop off and leave their bag in the Large Conference Room - H108 (adjacent to Cafe) between 4:30 – 5:15 p.m. on June 10th. Graduates' bags and belongings will be searched for unauthorized items, such as, open or closed cans or bottles, and at any time during the event that chaperones feel it is necessary to ensure the safety of all parties involved. Project Graduation will last until 6:30 a.m. the next day. Any student who attends the event **WILL NOT** be allowed to drive themselves home the following morning. Students must be driven home by either a parent/guardian or driver who has not participated in Project Graduation (or by an adult chaperone participating in Project Graduation). This is done for safety reasons, since the graduates will have been up for over 24 hours and will be very tired. Please make arrangements for your graduate to be picked up no later than 6:30a.m. on Saturday, June 11, 2022 at the Epping Community Church.

Parents and students, please read over the permission slip carefully so there are no misunderstandings of the rules. NO ONE can participate in this event without a signed permission slip. Signed permission slips are due **Monday, May 23, 2022**, to the high school main office.

## EPPING PROJECT GRADUATION – CLASS OF 2022 - PERMISSION SLIP

The Project Graduation Committee has been working hard since late Fall to plan the after-graduation celebration for the EHS Class of 2022. The committee is pleased to offer our Seniors a night of fun, safe activities to celebrate their achievement!

The party will begin immediately after the graduation ceremony. Graduates will report to the high school entrance where they will board the bus that will take them to the American Legion. Once at the Legion, students will have dinner, dance and enjoy a hypnotist show and other activities. Students will depart from the Legion at approximately 12:30am and arrive at Hilltop Fun Center in Somersworth by 1:00am where they will have the entire facility to enjoy for four hours. After they leave Hilltop, they will head to the Epping Community Church where they will be served breakfast.
