SUBJECT: State Performance Plan Data Requirements - Postsecondary School Survey
(Cohort 4)

The accountability requirement under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act of 2004 mandates that each state is to determine the extent to which students are achieving transition outcomes (State Performance Plan - Indicator 14). To meet the federal reporting requirement, each local educational agency (LEA) is mandated to administer Exit- and Post-School Surveys to students who have graduated, aged out, or drop out with individualized education programs (IEPs) once over a five year period, based on the LEA's assignment to a targeted sampling year (cohort).

During the 2018-19 school year, LEAs assigned to the target sample comprising Cohort 4 are required to administer Exit Surveys to students with IEPs who are identified as potential leavers. During the 2019-20 school year, these same LEAs will be required to complete the Post-School Surveys with youth who had IEPs and who exited high school the preceding academic year.

The following information specifically addresses Exit Survey administration for the 2018-19 school year. LEAs assigned to Cohort 4, as listed below, are required to address the following activities:

- Administer the Exit Survey for all student leavers (graduates, dropouts, and students who reach maximum age) who have individualized education programs;
- Participate in the Pennsylvania Post School Outcome Survey Overview for Cohort 4 webinar which is scheduled for September 26, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Information concerning the administration of Exit Surveys will be addressed. Registration is required and can be accessed at www.pattan.net; and
- Attend the February 20, 2019, Exit Survey training webinar from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Registration information will be provided on a PENN*LINK issued later in the year.
