*If your child is a current Young 5 student (2019 - 2020) at North Creek, there is no need to bring in any paperwork for your child. They are already in our system.

Your child can continue to access the learning apps that are on their iPad over the summer months. However, please note that the classrooms for Seesaw will be "archived" when school is out. Students will not have access to use that platform with their class/teacher since it is not being monitored by staff over the summer.

If your child will not be returning to CSD over the summer, please email Mrs. Gillow to notify her of your plans. We will need you to return your child's iPad before the summer begins.
