Hello again, South Meadows' Families,

I hope that you are staying safe and well. I know that as we approach late fall and a heavier cold and flu season, that worries about illness are increasing as well. Thank you for your continued diligence in monitoring your child's health and keeping him/her home if there are any symptoms that could potentially spread illness. As I mentioned last week, when dealing with any concerns surrounding COVID exposure, because it can take 3 to 4 days for test results to be finalized and shared with you, if anyone in your home is ill and is getting tested for COVID, it is important that you keep your child home until those test results come back.

Student Commitment Survey Thank you so much for completing your Trimester 2 commitment survey. I am working through all of the responses and numbers this week and will communicate first to staff, and then to you about any changes that need to be made to classroom placement. It is important to keep in mind that if you elected a **change in learning model**, that this will require a **change of classroom and teacher**. We have two staff members at each grade level who teach virtually and it is a vastly different experience and way of instructing from our Hybrid teachers. Thank you for appreciating the differences and understanding the difficulties trying to teach in both models would create for any teacher.

Report Cards Your child's first trimester report card will be available via PowerSchool beginning Wednesday, December 2nd. In order to access the report card, you will need to assure that you have your Parent PowerSchool Access Account set up. Next week we will be sending out information and directions for setting up and/or accessing this account for those of you who do not already have it.
