Acceptable Fan Behavior

- Be respectful of game officials, players, coaches, and opposing fans and facilities.
- Cheer positively during the introduction of players, coaches (of both teams) and officials.
- Cheer positively for both teams.
- Recognize outstanding performances on either side of the playing field.
- Be respectful of games officials, players, coaches, opposing fans, and facilities.

Unacceptable Fan Behavior

- Making derogatory chants, songs, or gestures
- Refrain from negative cheering and chants directed towards the either team
- Calling out an opponent's name or number
- Calling opponents derogatory nicknames
- Using horns or noise makers
- Throwing objects into a crowd or at an individual
- Distracting participants, obstructing vision, or directly affecting play
