



Galvin Middle School 2020 - 2021 Supply List

To help make this school year successful, we recommend students have the following supplies. This year, we created one list for grades 6-8 that takes into account the following considerations:

- students will have a 1:1 device so we have a decreased need for paper, notebooks, etc,
- students will not be able to share supplies given COVID guidelines, and
- Students will not be using lockers this year and will need to keep their belongings with them throughout the day

We highly recommend that if you already have some of these items in your home, you do not go out to buy new. Colored pencils, markers, scissors and more often last beyond one year!

- backpack
- 2-inch binder
- pocket folder dividers
- sheet protectors
- pencil/supply pouch that zips (could clip into binder)that includes the following:
 - pencils, pencil sharpener, pens, highlighters, ruler (with inches and centimeters), scissors, colored pencils, black Sharpie (thin or ultra thin), thin markers, dry erase markers (thin),and crayons.
- loose leaf paper or a notebook
- 2- marble composition notebooks (ELA, world language)
- 1- 5 subject notebook with folders
- graph paper notebook **(8th grade math only)**
- post it notes
- printer paper/drawing paper
- construction paper
- individual tissue pack(s)
- individual hand sanitizer
- Masks **Please note that bandanas, gaiters (neck scarves), masks with vents are not allowed per the CPS COVID Protocols*
