PROFILE: 2019-2020

Stoneham, a middle to upper-middle income suburban community of about 23,000 people located 10 miles north of Boston, is composed primarily of business, professional and semi-professional residents. Stoneham High School is a comprehensive, four-year public high school with an enrollment of approximately 649 students and accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. The vast majority of its 68 member teaching faculty hold advanced degrees of a master's degree or higher. As members of the Middlesex League, Stoneham High School student-athletes compete in over 20 varsity sports.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Stoneham High School operates on an 8 day, 5 period schedule. Full year courses earn 5 credits. Half-year or semester courses earn 2.5 credits. Students must earn a minimum of 115 credits and fulfill the following course requirements to graduate:
