# **Full Remote**

Stoneham High School will stay in a Remote Learning Model for approximately two weeks, with students scheduled to return, if it is appropriate to do so to a Hybrid Learning Model on Monday, November 30, 2020. In addition, the remainder of the fall Stoneham High School sports season will be cancelled.

During this two-week period, teachers will be providing instruction via the Remote Learning Model and following the remote schedule. Mr. Lombardi will be providing further information via email.
