**Scholarship Opportunity:** All seniors who are seeking a college degree or trade union job training are eligible to compete in the **Massachusetts AFL-CIO Scholarship Awards Program**, with awards totaling over half a million dollars. To qualify, students must register for an examination consisting of multiple-choice questions and an essay related to labor history. A study guide is available. There is a firm deadline of December 18, 2020 to register for the exam, which will be administered between Jan. 25 and Feb. 5, 2021.
