Athletics:

Starting Monday, November 30, 2020, FamilyID will be open for registering for winter sports. The winter sports for 2020-2021 season will be Boys and Girls Basketball, Gymnastics, Boys and Girls Ice Hockey. Reminder that all athletes must complete the FamilyID, bring in updated physical to the athletic office along with user fee payment. Payment can also be made on line through our school website. This must be all handed into the athletic office before Monday, December 14th. No athlete will be able to start without everything completed.

Scholarship Opportunity: All seniors who are seeking a college degree or trade union job training are eligible to compete in the **Massachusetts AFL-CIO Scholarship Awards Program**, with awards totaling over half a million dollars. To qualify, students must register for an examination consisting of multiple-choice questions and an essay related to labor history. A study guide is available. There is a firm deadline of December 18, 2020 to register for the exam, which will be administered between Jan. 25 and Feb. 5, 2021.
