

## School News



### Provision

This is Iron Academy's most important financial season, and we are ever-dependent on God's provision through His people to give. Consistent with our strategic plan, we have dramatically reduced the gap between revenue and spending and fully expect tuition and fees to cover core school costs by 2022. In the meantime, however, we need your energetic financial support.

Our goal this season is to raise \$125,000. While the amount is the least daunting in our history, we want to implore you not to lose a sense of urgency in helping us fulfill God's unique calling. The sum of \$125,000 represents the gap in what it costs to educate your sons and the amount of money we charge in tuition and fees. **We need to raise roughly \$1,700 per student to bridge this gap.** Frankly, this is all about paying our teachers.

God has asked us to do something unlike anything else in the world. Yes, that's a scary place to be, but His people have allowed us to survive and are now preparing us to thrive. None of this happens without you. Specifically, I'm asking you to **give heartily now!** As an Iron parent, we

rightfully rely first and foremost upon you and your commitment.
