In light of the recent events taking place with COVID-19, I wanted to reach out and give you an update.

First, until we get clear direction from the Department of Education and or our local Health Departments, LaVille plans to continue with school as normal. However, this is subject to change should we be given a mandate by one of those organizations. In the event school is closed, we will plan for eLearning days until a normal schedule is allowed.

If you have a special situation placing a member of your family in danger due to the person's health condition, I ask you to contact your principals to let them know. Your principals will try to work with you to keep everyone safe from the spread of the virus.

Secondly, our custodial staff has been sanitizing each desktop in the evening each day. This practice will continue. The group will include the doorknobs and railings throughout the school, and they will clean each locker combination and handle daily. Meanwhile, teachers will continue to direct students to use hand sanitizer, or hand soap and water. Please join us in stressing acceptable hygiene practices to your students.

Finally, LaVille will follow the same path as other organizations throughout our state and nation by reducing or eliminating crowds. For example, Saturday evening's fish fry will now be carryout only in order to reduce the amount of people gathering in one place.
