After consultation with the St. Joseph and Marshall County Health Departments, the decision has been made for LaVille to return to In-Person Learning this coming Monday, November 30th, as previously planned. Return at the Jr. Sr. High level was based on the fact we have already stayed away for an incubation period of 14 days. In addition, according to the Health Department, the transmission of the virus from Elementary students is very low.

We know this is going to be a very tough stretch through the holidays and decisions may be changing quickly as new information evolves. In order for us to stay in Stage 1, In-Person schooling, we will need everyone's help to stop the spread. If you or someone in your household is not feeling well, please don't take the chance and send your student/s to school.
