Our drivers are certified, experienced and courteous. We are committed to providing a safe, comfortable and timely ride with an affordable price. Our modern full-sized busses are equipped with heating, air conditioning and seat belts. Passengers are required to fasten their seat belts for safety.

Our drivers keep track of attendance every morning and afternoon. Riders have the option of paying the drivers in cash for each one-way trip, or the actual number of one-way trips ridden will be reflected on your monthly statement, which you will receive in the mail.

On some occasions, school vans driven by school staff members may be dispatched to assist on the routes.
