- Guests:** Prom is a Senior class event however, current PHS or outside Juniors and Sophomores, with a current school year I.D. card, may accompany Seniors to Prom with certain restrictions. Older guests, not exceeding the age of 21, may be approved at the discretion of the Dean of Students. A Guest Pass for all non-PHS students must be completed and turned in to Ms. Kirsch by the above date. Guests must bring their school I.D. card to the dance. Furthermore, **by signing this contract, all students and parents agree that PHS supervision of students ends and parent/guardian supervision of students begins upon the students' departure from the Sheraton-Universal.**
