## **Child Find Notice: Littleton Public Schools**

It is the responsibility of the Littleton Public Schools to identify any child who is a resident of Littleton, who may have a disability, regardless of the severity of the disability. It is also the responsibility of the Littleton Public Schools to evaluate those students to determine if they are eligible for special education or related services under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) or 306 CMR 28 (Massachusetts Special Education Regulations).

The Littleton Public Schools is committed to identifying children before their third birthday in order to provide early intervention services for three and four year olds. If you have questions or concerns regarding your young child's development and would like to have your child screened, please call Allison Gilman, PK-5 Special Education Team Chairperson at 978-486-3959 for an appointment.

If you have concerns about your child, at any age, please contact the Principal at your child's school for information about referring your child for an evaluation.
