Dear Littleton Families,

We hope that this letter finds you well and keeping cool in the current heat! Thank you for responding to our latest survey that was sent on July 15th titled ‘Back to School Planning - Family Survey’. This survey closed on July 24th and we are happy to provide a summary of the results to you [here](#). We know that there are still many questions about how we can and will safely resume learning and our task forces are working hard to creatively generate solutions. As you are aware we are in the process of generating three learning plans, in-person, hybrid, and remote, as required by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. Once all three learning plans are created we will send a third survey to families seeking input on their educational plans for their child(ren) and comfort level with reopening schools. We anticipate that survey to be similar to the one summarized above and to be sent out within the first two weeks of August.

Please remember that beginning this week and continuing into next week each building principal will be facilitating a parent forum during which they will provide an overview of the three learning plans. These forums will be recorded by LCTV and made available to you at a later date if you are not able to attend the live forum. We really appreciate the assistance and support from LCTV and the partnership that they enable between families and the Littleton Public Schools by means of airing meetings. Since the meetings will be recorded by LCTV, we needed to update the meeting links. 
