Dear Littleton Families,

We hope you enjoyed the weekend. At our August 13th School Committee meeting a decision was made to begin the school year using a hybrid model of instruction. We will continue to monitor the COVID-19 health metrics in the weeks prior to the start of the school year and if necessary, will revisit the decision that was made at the August 13th School Committee meeting. **In order to prepare schedules and cohort groupings, we ask that any family wanting to opt out of the hybrid model to please complete this [Remote Learning Registration](#) by Monday, August 24th. Completing this form indicates that your child(ren) will begin the 2020-2021 school year in a remote learning model.** If you complete this form preferring to start the year in a remote learning model, we ask that you commit to that model for the first semester (grades PreK and K), first trimester (grades 1-8) or first quarter (grades 9-12) of the school year. We understand that circumstances may change during the school year and therefore you may request to change the learning model once the year begins. We will make a Learning Model Change Request form available at a later date to families.
