**ARTICLES**

**Article 02.** Shall the Newmarket School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by the vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling **\$21,009,877**? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be **\$20,786,178** which is the same as last year with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Newmarket School District or by law; or the school board may hold one special meeting in accordance with RSA 40:13 X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (Majority vote required) *Recommended by the School Board 5-0. Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 9-0.*

NOTE: This warrant article (operating budget) does not include appropriations in ANY other warrant article. If passed, it is estimated that this article will result in an increase of \$0.43 over the previous year's school tax rate of \$21.69, **which will result in a new estimated tax rate of \$22.12**. If defeated, it is estimated that this article will result in an increase of \$0.13 over the previous year's school rate of \$21.69 **which will result in a new estimated tax rate of \$21.82**.
