Tournament Format: Round Robin Format, we will have 2 matches going on at the same time in our high school gym. Match times will be 9:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 11:00 AM.

Matches will be best 2 out of 3 sets. Third set will be played to 15 points.

Awards: Plaques will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place teams.

Tiebreaker: 1) Head to Head 2) W/L % of all sets in all matches 3) Total point differential of from all sets and all matches

Warm-ups: 14 minute warm up prior to first game, then 11 minute warm-up prior to matches 2 and 3. Clock will start immediately after the conclusion of the previous match.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Attendance Information: We are in Phase 4 of the State of Nebraska's DHM but are still using some of the Phase 3 directives.

*We will be using a pass list for this event. Each participant is allowed up to **THREE** people for this tournament because bleacher seating will be limited with two courts being used at one time. Please go to the following link (<https://forms.gle/OwFTKMRTVESemI3XA>) and follow the directions to submit your pass list.*

No individual (player, coach, manager, videographer, stat keeper, spectator, or other) should attend the tournament if experiencing any of the following:

- **Fever of 100.4F or above, chills**
- **Sudden onset of a cough**
- **Sudden onset of shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**
- **Muscle or body aches**
- **New loss of taste or smell**
- **Sore throat**
- **Nausea or vomiting**
- **Diarrhea**

Each school is responsible for temperature checking and symptom screening their athletes, coaches, managers, and bus driver(s) prior to arrival.

Team Masking: Players, coaches, and team personnel are encouraged to mask when they are not in the gym. Masking by team personnel is optional while in the gym. Masks may be worn by players while competing but they must meet all NFHS / NSAA guidelines. Table help is also encouraged to wear a mask.

Locker Room: Please come dressed as we will not be able to supply a locker room for this event.

Benches: Teams will not switch benches during the match.

Water: Per the Phase 3 DHM, "Players must bring their own water/beverage to consume during and after practice/games. No shared/communal drinking fountains or coolers." For that reason, please bring your own water/beverages as we do not plan to supply a water cooler at the bench area. There is a water refill station within the drinking fountain just outside of the gym near the restrooms.

Equipment: Please bring your own balls and cart for warm up. We will sanitize game balls periodically throughout the contest. Per the State of Nebraska's Phase 3 DHM, "players should not share towels, water bottles, or other equipment."

Pregame / Postgame: Handshakes are prohibited. Fans and players are asked to leave the gym and return to their vehicles as quickly as possible after the tournament.

Spectators: All visiting spectators must be on the entry / pass list prior to the event. All spectators will need to be temperature checked at the gate so please arrive early. Spectators are strongly encouraged to wear masks and asked to socially distance.

Spectators are encouraged to spread out as much as possible. Spectators should avoid intermingling with fans from other schools.

All children 5th Grade and younger must sit with their parents and be supervised at all times.

Concessions: Regular concession stand food items will be offered. All fans are strongly encouraged to wear masks and practice social distancing while waiting in line.
