Dear Students, Parents/Guardians,

Martin Luther School would like to wish you and your family a blessed summer. As you begin your summer shopping MLS would like to take this opportunity to inform and remind you of the 2020-2021 Dress Code Policy.

Wearing the school uniform plays an important role in establishing a positive community identity and contributes to the creation of an appropriate work ethic. Acceptance of enrollment at Martin Luther Middle and High School assumes an agreement between the parent/guardian and the enrolling student that the student will dress in accordance with the school's uniform policy. Students are to wear the designated coordinates to and from school and during school hours. Parents/guardians are asked to cooperate by ensuring that students wear their uniform to school each day.

**\*\*The short or long sleeve polo shirt with school logo must be worn every day**

***Physical Education attire will be addressed during orientation.***

In addition pants, shorts, skirt, crew neck sweater with logo, v neck cardigan with logo, sweater vest with logo, polar fleece with logo are available from Flynn O'Hara. ***Please label your child's belongings.***

**\*\*Plain Black Denim Jeans are permitted** (no patterns/designs, studs/tags, drapped legs or elastic ankle, not ripped torn or frayed). **No athletic/sports/leggings, spandex/yoga pants allowed.**

**\*\*Footwear:** All solid black loafers or tie shoes are allowed. All solid black sneakers may be worn. **NO Crocs, sliders, boots etc.**

Students will be instructed and reminded about these mandatory dress code policies during orientation.

Administrators and staff will be responsible for making final determinations as to whether a student's attire or appearance is in conflict with the written policies. Students violating the dress code policy shall be subject to correction and disciplinary action according to MLS Code of Conduct.

Throughout the year there will be special dress down days (Pep Rally, Dress Down, College, Spirit) each with specific guidelines and instructions. These will be communicated ahead of time.

Kindly, have a conversation with your child supporting our dress code guidelines.

**Please note: Due to Covid 19 it is important for you to talk to your child about their belongings. No sharing of items is permitted. Clothing must be taken home daily, especially P.E., Athletic/Practice attire and washed.**
